


There are a total of three doors for you to access your books. There is the colored acrylic panel that will reflect pattenen and color onto the ground

Dimensioned Example




construction Detail

The Little Free Library will be six feet tall but the highest book high is at 4'-6" and lowest at 0'-6" the width 1'-6". The acrylic panel will be 2'-3" in total width and 5'-6" in hight.
